- * Watercolor paint: Windsor & Newton basic colors, such as cadmium yellow, cadmium red, sap green, indigo, Windsor violet, raw sienna and burnt umber. Under the Daniel Smith paint brand: cascade green, cerulean blue, French ultramarine and moonglow.
- * Watercolor paper: no larger than 12" x 16" (cold-pressed, at least 140lb.) Recommended: Arches Brand watercolor paper in 140lb. on block or in a pad.
- * Brushes: an assortment of synthetic watercolor brushes in both "flat" and "round". Suggested sizes are #2, #6, #10, #16
- *Liquid friskit (a masking fluid)
- * Paper towels
- * Two small cups to hold water
- *Watercolor palette (Mijello Fusion 33 is recommended) or tray to hold your paints.
- * Roll of blue removable painters tape

If you already have your own watercolor supplies, please bring what you have. You can always add more as needed.
